1. I was allotted Russian as Compulsory Foreign Language and was posted to Moscow from Jakarta.
2. My posting to Moscow was reviewed at the last moment and I was posted back to the Headquarters in August, 2017.
3. I was again posted to Guatemala and resumed my duties on November 4, 2017.

The facility for learning Russian is not available in this country. Ministry is requested to consider to exempt me from Compulsory Foreign Language since I am retiring from service on September 30, 2019 and have left only 19 months of service.
